

CIVILIAN ECONOMIC CRIMES INVESTIGATOR, DISTRICT ATTORNEY

PHYSICAL, MENTAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

The County of Orange is committed to providing a means for applicants who may have a disability to identify areas in which they may request a reasonable accommodation. The following is a description of the physical and mental abilities which are customarily required to perform the essential job functions of this position. Applicants are encouraged to contact the recruiter listed in the announcement for any questions or to request an accommodation during the testing/selection process.

Physical and Mental Characteristics: Ability to perform active investigative role, **body strength sufficient** to recover evidence and transport boxes; **independent body mobility** to drive a vehicle, perform various law enforcement related searches, access a standard office, and exert moderate physical effort involving some combination of stooping, kneeling, crouching, lifting, carrying, pushing or pulling and prolonged standing; **vision** sufficient enough to read typed and handwritten documents, a computer screen, to drive a vehicle, and to recognize and identify similarities or differences between characteristics of colors and forms; **manual dexterity** to operate a computer keyboard to complete reports and do informational queries; **stamina** to enter, drive, and exit a vehicle several times in one day, in all forms of weather conditions, and to operate equipment and machinery, requiring simple but continuous adjustments, such as County vehicles, computer keyboards, tape recorders, telephones, fax machines, photocopiers, and camera/audio/video equipment; ability to **speak and hear** well enough to converse in person and on the phone; **hearing** sufficient to recognize differing sounds; **smell and touch** sufficient to detect odors and textures associated with job-related objects, materials, and tasks.

Sufficient **eye, hand, feet and limb coordination** to perform semi-skilled movements, such as conducting searches of businesses and residences.

Mental stamina for complex problem solving and dealing with stressful situations; ability to recall and recreate detailed conversation or events, interpret and apply oral/written instructions; remain alert and coherent to take action or to decide alternative courses of action under routine, highly stressful, or environmentally difficult conditions.

Functional reasoning ability and rational judgment sufficient to performing diversified work activities; and judgment, decisiveness and creativity sufficient to evaluate information against sensory and/or judgmental criteria.

Environmental Conditions: Will be required to perform office work and field investigative assignments, use personal vehicle for travel (with mileage reimbursement), interview uncooperative individuals, conduct surveillances, and travel outside of Orange County. May be required to work in an environment where exposure to environmental factors such as odors, dust, noise, disease, or machinery may constitute discomfort.
