



How we commute to work impacts traffic congestion and air quality in the region. To assist you in making an informed decision on how to get to work, the County of Orange Human Resources created the **Commuter Assistance Program (CAP)**. Employees are provided with ridesharing information through presentations, integrated web site, quarterly on-line newsletter, and a network of commuter information displays managed by on-site coordinators.

The CAP includes the following incentives and reward programs:

Commuter Choice — Employees can purchase their bus, rail or vanpool passes through payroll deduction using up to \$115 per month of pre-tax dollars, thus reducing their taxable income. This means that you will pay less income tax!



Commuter Club — Employees who rideshare (walk, bike, carpool, vanpool, bus, train) to work a minimum of five days per month can receive a Commuter Club card honored by local merchants for special discounts. Members also receive an annual thank you gift, and are entered into quarterly prize drawings.



Try the Train or Bus — Employees who are interested in taking a Metrolink train or OCTA bus to work can receive a one or two day pass to give it a try. If you like your new commute and sign up for the Commuter Choice program, we'll pay for your first



month's pass. A similar program for employees who join a vanpool is also available—we'll pay for your first month when you sign up for the Commuter Choice program.

Carpool Classified — If you would like help finding a fellow employee to carpool with to work, you can add your name to a register of County employees also looking for a carpool match.



Guaranteed Return Trip — All ridesharing employees are eligible for the regional guaranteed ride home program that provides a ride home in case of a personal emergency, unexpected overtime, etc.
