Wedding Day Jackpot!

Over 130 couples have signed up so far to be part of Orange County's "Lucky in Love" wedding extravaganza on Saturday, heralded internationally as the century's luckiest day – 7/7/7.

Tom Daly, Orange County's Clerk-Recorder and Commissioner of Marriages, will open the marriage license office this Saturday only to accommodate couples hoping to hit the matrimonial jackpot. County offices normally close on weekends.

Keeping with the Lucky 7 theme, marriage offices at the picturesque Old County Courthouse in Santa Ana will open at 7:00 a.m. and remain open for 7 hours, until 2:00 p.m. Reservations for wedding ceremonies are being offered in time slots containing the number 7. Seven individual appointments will be offered in each time slot.

Daly's staff will perform the ceremonies inside Orange County's historic first courthouse at 211 W. Santa Ana Blvd. in the Santa Ana Civic Center area. Outdoor weddings are also being offered on the picturesque courthouse lawn.

Because 7/7/7 is considered to be such a special day, and most other wedding venues already have been booked, Daly said he decided to help as many couples as possible enjoy their dream wedding date. "And we guarantee it'll be easier to remember your anniversary," he said.
