NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California, will receive sealed bids up to 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, the ~~eighth~~ twenty-ninth of February 2012 in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Room 101, Hall of Administration, 10 Civic Center Plaza, Santa Ana, California 92701 (corner of Santa Ana Boulevard and Broadway), at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in Room 169 on the first floor of the Hall of Administration for the following:

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2. In general, the project includes unclassified excavation, unclassified fill, low permeability material processing and placement, construction of an 80-mil HDPE geosynthetic liner, construction of sub drain and leachate collection systems, installation of a 24 inch cement mortar lined and coated steel pipe water main, and miscellaneous erosion control and civil improvements at the Prima Deshecha Landfill.
3. All of said work is to be performed in accordance with **Plans and Specifications available at ARC Reprographics, Inc., 504 West Chapman Avenue, Unit A, Orange, CA 92868, telephone: (714) 532-4852. Plans and Specifications available electronically at the BIDSYNC website: <https://www.bidsync.com>**. The Contractor shall perform work under the direction of an on-site construction management and a quality assurance firm or the OC Waste & Recycling project manager, at rates established in the bid.
4. The classification of Contractor's license required in the performance of this contract is A. The Contractor and all Subcontractors shall have all licenses required by the State for the type of work being done. **The Contractor shall meet the minimum experience qualifications outlined in the Bid Proposal (Page 17).**
5. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1773 of the Labor Code of the state of California, the contractor shall comply with the general prevailing rates of per diem wages and the general prevailing rates for holiday and overtime wages in this locality for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute this contract. The rates are available from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations at the following website: <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/DPreWageDetermination.htm>. The contractor shall post a copy of such wage rates at the job site and shall pay the adopted prevailing wage rates. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of Sections 1775 and 1813 of the Labor Code.
6. Each bidder must submit, with his or her bid, a satisfactory check certified by a responsible bank, or a bidder's bond, issued and executed by an admitted surety authorized to transact surety insurance in California, and made payable to the order of the County of Orange, in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total bid amount, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed contract if the same is awarded him or her. In the event of failure to enter into such contract, the proceeds of the check will be forfeited or, in case of a bond, the full sum thereof will be forfeited to said County of Orange.
7. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Faithful Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the amount of the contract and a Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the contract. Said bonds are to be in substantially the same form as the bonds contained in the Contract Documents and are to be first approved by the County Counsel and the Risk Manager of Orange County.

8. Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, the contract will contain provisions permitting the successful bidder to substitute securities for any monies withheld by the County of Orange to ensure performance under the contract.
9. A mandatory pre-bid site meeting and walkthrough will be held on ~~January 11, 2012~~ February 1, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. The meeting place will be at the Prima Deshecha Landfill, 32250 La Pata Avenue, San Juan Capistrano CA 92675. Access is via La Pata Avenue, which intersects Ortega Highway, two miles east of the San Diego Freeway. OC Waste & Recycling will note any contractor that arrives late at the pre-bid site meeting. If any of the noted late contractors turn out to be the low bidder, the County of Orange Board of Supervisors would determine if their bid would be viewed as responsive. Failure to attend this mandatory pre-bid meeting will render the bid non-responsive. If you have any questions, please contact John Powers, Project Manager at (949) 728-3055.
10. Project Milestones: It is anticipated that a Noticed to Proceed will be issued with an effective commencement date in the July/August period of 2012. Regardless of the actual date that is established for the start of construction, no work shall be scheduled for the Phase B Stockpile area until AFTER September 15, 2012.

Additionally, the Contractor shall grade and pave the new access road (Sheet 4) prior to demolition of the existing landfill access road.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities of any bid received.
