Summary

Please replace the last paragraph of the Background Information with the following paragraph:

The County received the RFP for Adult Alien Detention Services for ICE Detainees on February 5, 2010, and ICE requires a response from the County no later than 30 days after issuance of the RFP. Therefore, the County's proposal must be submitted to ICE by March 8, 2010. The Sheriff-Coroner Department, Health Care Agency and CEO are in the process of completing the proposal. ICE requires that the

proposal be signed by an individual who has the authority to commit the County to the information contained in the proposal, and that the individual signing the proposal attend any and all negotiations and pre-performance conferences. It is requested that County staff from the Sheriff-Coroner Department, Health Care Agency and CEO, who will participate in the development of the proposal, negotiations of the IGSA and pre-performance conferences, be authorized to submit the proposal on behalf of the County. Representatives from County Counsel will also participate in the development of the proposal and the negotiation of the IGSA.

Please add the following paragraph to the Background Information:

This action is not a project within the meaning of CEQA Guidelines section 15378 and is therefore exempt from CEQA, because it will not result in any direct or indirect physical change in the environment and does not involve an irrevocable commitment of resources by the County to the activity. This is a mere authorization of exploratory action that may lead to negotiation of an agreement. It is therefore exempt from CEQA. Any future action that could directly or indirectly result in a physical change in the environment (e.g., a negotiated contract subject to Board approval) will return to the Board of Supervisors for consideration accompanied by appropriate CEQA documentation.
