Dear Nadeem,

We received the bid results dated June 7, 2006, for the Peters Canyon Channel Trail undercrossings. Since receiving these results our agencies have been discussing various construction and funding alternatives. We understand the County is now committed to award a construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder, KEC Engineering, at a contract price of \$6,102,769.00. This considers the reinforced concrete wall alternative in lieu of the segment wall alternative. (The City prefers the construction of the segment wall option but we hereby approve either alternative.)

As we discussed, the City of Irvine approves the award of this bid contingent upon the City's financial obligation not exceeding \$4.5 million. We understand that the Orange County Flood Control District will be financially responsible for any costs above this \$4.5 million amount. This responsibility by the District includes payment of all project costs including but not limited to design, construction, contract change orders, administration, and mitigation. Please forward written acknowledgement of financial commitment by the Orange County Flood Control District.
