Summary

The Health Care Agency (HCA) requires pick-up and disposal of medical and pharmaceutical waste at various sites throughout the County in order to support routine program operations and comply with the California Health & Safety Code, Chapter 6, Sections 118000-118045. Currently, HCA programs that generate medical waste and utilize these services include: Medical & Institutional Health, Behavioral Health, and Public Health Services.

On October 2006, an Invitation for Bid was conducted and four bids were received. Medadent Biomedical, Inc., was selected, because it was determined to be the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. After contract negotiation, Medadent Biomedical, Inc., was acquired by Stericycle, Inc. Stericycle, Inc., is the successor-in-interest with respect to the rights and obligations as related to the agreement with the County.

The subject project is categorically exempt (Class 1) from provisions of CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines.

The agreement contains language which permits reduction or termination without penalty if approved funding or appropriations are not forthcoming.

The Health Care Agency requests that your Honorable Board authorize the Purchasing Agent or designee to execute Price Agreement with Stericycle, Inc., as referenced in the Recommended Action.
