RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
ORANGE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT,  
COUNTY OF ORANGE

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has made grant money available to local entities for local levee repair through its Department of Water Resources (DWR) in accordance with the terms and conditions of California Public Resources Code Section 75032;

WHEREAS, the Director of Orange County Public Works on behalf of the Orange County Flood Control District (District) requests authority to obtain funding from the DWR for the repair of San Juan Creek Levee pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 75032; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the grant application, an engineer licensed under the laws of the State of California must certify that the project is necessary because the flood control system has been critically damaged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board acting on behalf of the Orange County Flood Control District does hereby:

1. Authorize the Director or his designee (Director) pursuant to and subject to all of the terms and provisions of California Public Resources Code Section 75032 to submit an application on behalf of the District to DWR to obtain grant funding for repairs to the San Juan Creek Levee.
2. The Director is hereby authorized to prepare the necessary data, make investigations, sign certifications required as part of this application, sign and file such application, and to invoice DWR for payment of allocated funds as appropriate.
3. Find that the project, as certified by a District Engineer, is necessary because the flood control system has been critically damaged.
