RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

By the authority of the Orange County Board of Supervisors, the following resolution is hereby issued:

WHEREAS, the men and women of the United States Marine Corps sacrifice day in and day out for the safety and freedom of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, in honor of the service to country that our brave Marines have made, the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation has provided a means for their children to receive higher education for nearly 50 years; and

WHEREAS, from the vision of Brigadier General Martin F. Rockmore in 1962, and an initial fundraising that sent the child of a Medal of Honor recipient to college, the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation was created to empower the children of Marines through education; and

WHEREAS, since its inception, this foundation has awarded more than 25,000 scholarships worth more than \$60 million, including more than 1,400 for the 2010-2011 academic year, to the deserving students of our men and women in the Marines; and

WHEREAS, the Scholarship Foundation has recognized Mr. Parker S. Kennedy with the 2010 Semper Fidelis Award as he has displayed honor, courage, and patriotism, the core values of the Marine Corps, within the business community; and

WHEREAS, the County of Orange is forever grateful to the men and women of the Marine Corps as well as all branches of the United States Armed Forces, and commends the Scholarship Foundation for their generosity to the family of Marines;
