PLEASE SEE THE CHANGES TO THE PREVIOUS AGENDA ITEM:

On July 29, 2008, our Board placed a charter amendment on the November 4, 2008 ballot that would require voter approval of increases of retirement benefits for County employees. Elections Code Section 9162 provides that up to five individuals may sign a ballot argument and that the Board of Supervisors or any member or members of the Board authorized by the Board may sign an argument in favor or against a County ballot measure. The deadline for the submittal of arguments is August 8, 2008. I have submitted an argument on that date signed by ~~Supervisor Bill Campbell, Supervisor Bates and myself.~~ I ask that the Board, acting pursuant to Elections Code 9162, authorize my filing of that argument. I also ask that the Board authorize my filing of a rebuttal argument by August 18, 2008 to any argument that may be filed against the proposed charter amendment.


