*WHEREAS, The Honorable Lynn Daucher served the people of the 72<sup>nd</sup> Assembly District in outstanding, and diligent fashion; and*

*WHEREAS, throughout her life, Lynn Daucher has always had a passion to serve; after graduating cum laude from the University of Rochester, she initially served in the education profession as a teacher; she has never lost sight of the gifts a great teacher can bestow on her children and community; it is no accident that Ms. Daucher found public service to be her calling; and*
