SUMMARY:

November 2013 marked the 15-year anniversary of the passage of Proposition 10. Beginning in November, the Commission independently and in partnership with First 5 commissions across the state has used this opportunity to recognize the transformative effect the legislation has had on health, early education, and family support services for young children and families. This item is an update on the 15-year anniversary activities over the past six-months.

DISCUSSION:**15-Year Anniversary Report**

A report on Commission's accomplishments and milestone events over the past 15-years was presented to the Commission in November and distributed to legislators, policy leaders, and partners. The report highlights the impact of Proposition 10 funding in the areas of health, early education, and family support to achieve the vision that all children are healthy and ready to learn. As Proposition 10 revenue continues to decline, the Commission is developing partnerships with public and other philanthropic organizations on alternative strategies for developing, funding, and implementing critical services. The report emphasizes the Commission's priority on evaluation, collaboration, convening, and policy leadership for children's issues. The report also includes data to support the four priority areas: autism, vision, early literacy and math, and obesity prevention. The report concludes with a focus on sustainability strategies to support the system of services for young children.

Statewide Reception and Advocacy Day

The First 5 Association coordinated a reception at the State Capitol in April 2014 hosted by Assembly Speaker John Perez. The reception celebrated the 15-year anniversary of the passage of Proposition 10 that created the First 5 Commissions that fund programs that provide health and child development programs to young children and families in California. Over 15 First 5 county commissions participated in the event that also included legislative representatives. The event provided in opportunity to meet with Orange County legislative representatives to brief them on the implementation of Proposition 10 in the county. The legislators were familiar with the Commission's work and supportive of the impact in the community.

Partner Recognition

The Commission has continually supported a wide range of organizations that have worked diligently to improve the health and development of young children. The breadth of the Commission's partnership with the Orange County community is illustrated in the number of agencies that have received funding over the years. Over 200 government, education, community, and faith-based organizations have partnered with the Commission over the years. A comprehensive list of partners since the Commission began funding programs is included as Attachment 1. In honor of the Commission's partners that provide valuable services to children and families, a placard (Attachment 2) has been created to display in their place of business recognizing their leadership to ensure every child is healthy and ready to learn.

Commission Open House

In October 2013 the Children and Families Commission moved to a new office suite at *The Village at 17th Street, a Non-Profit Center* in Santa Ana. The Village is a multi-tenant nonprofit center that was created in June 2010 to strengthen Orange County's nonprofit organizations. In addition to reduced lease costs, the amenities at the new site include common area facilities, board rooms, training facilities and staff lounges. The Village is also home to several nonprofit organizations supported by the Commission and is centrally located to provide easier access to funded programs. An Open House of the new office is scheduled to immediately follow the April 2, 2014 Commission meeting. In addition to the Commissioners, both current and former organizations that have partnered with the Commission over the past 15 years are invited to attend. The Village tenants will also participate in the Open House and have materials about their organizations available.
