**SUBJECT:** Assignment of Existing Agreements with St. Jude Hospital due to Change in Ownership

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**SUMMARY:**

The Children and Families Commission currently contracts with St. Jude Hospital to provide health care services through the Commission's community clinic program. St. Jude Hospital is participating in the catalytic investment awarded to the community clinics to obtain Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC) status. This change of ownership is a necessary step due to the requirements for FQHCs to have a community representative governing structure.

On September 1, 2012, the change of ownership to the new not-for-profit corporation St. Jude Neighborhood Health Centers will take effect. In order to avoid a disruption in services, approval of assignment of all rights and responsibilities in these agreements to the new corporation is requested. The change of ownership of St. Jude Hospital has been approved by the California Department of Public Health.
