**SUBJECT:** Shari Freidenrich, Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector

Shari Freidenrich was elected as Orange County's Treasurer-Tax Collector in November 2010 and re-elected in 2014. She is responsible for overseeing the county's \$7 billion investment pool and serves as a trustee for the \$12 billion Orange County Employee Retirement System. Shari also is a member of the Audit Oversight Committee and the Public Financing Advisory Committee. Since May 2012, the Orange County Treasurer has been designated annually to serve as the Commission's Treasurer with authority to manage, deposit and invest Commission funds.

Prior to her service with the County of Orange, Shari was elected as the City of Huntington Beach Treasurer from 1996 to 2010. Shari was also previously the Controller for McDonnell Douglas Travel Company (now Boeing Travel Company). She worked for McDonnell Douglas Corporation as an Auditing Specialist and started her career with Deloitte & Touche, an international accounting firm.

She holds a Bachelor's Degree from Washington State University in Business Administration with an emphasis in Accounting and graduated summa cum laude. Shari is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) as well as a Certified California Municipal Treasurer (CCMT), a Certified Public Finance Administrator (CPFA), a Certified Public Finance Investment Manager (CPFIM) and an Advanced Certified Public Finance Investment Manager (ACPFIM). She is a Past President for the Association of Public Treasurers of the United States and Canada and is also a Past President of the California Municipal Treasurer's Association. Shari was elected to the Board of Governors for Washington State University Foundation in 2014 and is currently serving as the Chair of the Audit Committee.
